Gifts of the Spirit to the Church

A Spiritual Gift is a special <u>ability</u> given by the Holy Spirit to each believer to be used to minister to others and build up the Body of Christ.

Below is a limited list of Spiritual Gifts including a simple definition and statements of testimony of someone blessed with that gift.

Administration (Acts 6:1-7) Organizing and administering with ease and efficiency. Sees needs and has ideas and creative ways to solve difficult situations.

- I can organize ideas, resources, time and people well.
- I easily delegate significant responsibilities to other people.
- I am a very organized person who sets goals and makes plans to reach them.

Discernment (1 John 4:1-6) Judging between the authentic and inauthentic teaching and motives.

- I am able to sense the true motivation of persons and movements.
- I can sense when a person is acting under God's leadership.

I can sense whether the source of a teaching is Satan, Self, or God's Spirit.

Evangelism (Acts 8:26-40) Presenting the Gospel with exceptional clarity and a deep burden.

- I have a special ability to communicate the truth of salvation to nonbelievers.
- I am able to share the gospel in such a way that people trust Christ as their Savior.
- I feel at ease in sharing Christ with nonbelievers.

Exhortation or Encouragement (Acts 14:22) Encouraging, comforting, assuring, and/or pointing out areas of disobedience and appealing for needed action.

- I inspire people to right actions by pointing out the blessings of God's path.
- I have a natural tendency to encourage and reward others.
- God has used me to encourage others to live Christ-like lives.

Faith (Romans 4:18-21) Seeing something that needs to be done and helping others to believe that God will do it, even though it looks impossible.

- I can trust God even when things look dark.
- I am able to believe in God for things when others have given up hope.
- I feel assured that things will change for God's glory even when it seems impossible.

Giving (2 Corinthians 8:1-7) Giving money or possessions for the work of the Lord freely and sacrificially with such wisdom and cheerfulness that others are encouraged and enriched.

- I experience joy in meeting needs through sharing my possessions.
- I am a generous and cheerful giver.
- I have an unusual ability to be self-sacrificing in giving of my resources.

Helping or Serving (Titus 3:14) Working faithfully behind the scenes in practical ways so as to assist in the work of the Lord and encourage and strengthen others spiritually.

- I enjoy doing things that make a difference for people in need.
- I love to do little things for people.
- I prefer helping others without receiving recognition.

Leadership (Hebrews 13:17) Impacting vision and giving positive direction to people. Seeing problems as opportunities.

- I can guide and manage a group of people toward achieving a specific goal.
- I don't mind asking others to accomplish an important ministry for my church.
- I can plan a strategy that brings others aboard.

Mercy (Luke 10:30-37) Empathizing and giving aid to those in need, including those with mental, emotional, or physical hurts.

- I am sensitive to the hurts of others.
- I am drawn to people who are hurting.
- I possess an unusual capacity to understand the feelings of those in distress.

Shepherding (1 Peter 5:2-4) Being a pastor or mentor to God's people and presenting the Scripture in a way which motivates and leads people in their Christian growth.

- I have God-given ability to help others grow in their faith.
- I am willing to take the initiative in helping other Christians grow in their faith.
- I am able to nurture others.

Teaching (Acts 18:24-28) Studying the Word and communicating clearly the truths and applications of the Word.

- I have an ability and desire to teach.
- I explain Scripture in such a way that others understand it.
- I can give a clear, uncomplicated presentation.

Wisdom (1 Corinthians 2:6-16) Applying the doctrines and principles of the Word of God to specific situations in a way that gives others fresh insight.

- I can usually relate the truths of God to specific situations.
- I am usually able to analyze a situation correctly.
- I can usually see spiritual solutions to problems.
