Violence Easter celebrates Jesus' resurrection as God overcomes the powers of fear, sin, violence, and death. It is a good time to ponder now how our faith can counter destructive forces today. The mass killings in Atlanta, Boulder, five other mass killings in 2021 and the thousands of additional deaths from guns are all tragic.
