Over the last few years, we have received backpacks filled with supplies from a very generous group of folks from Cornell. This year due to the COVID pandemic they regretfully cannot provide this service. This year is different in so many ways and is providing challenges we have never experienced before. We can no longer allow students to share supplies. Each child will need their own box of supplies. If you are willing and able to purchase some needed supplies it would be greatly appreciated. The list that would be most helpful include:

crayons individual pencil boxes pencils children's scissors
glue sticks dry erase markers black and blue pens backpacks
personal size packs of small tissues (like the ones you carry in purses)

There are several ways to donate. If you would prefer to do a financial donation, you can send a check to Dryden Central School and in the "memo" section indicate "supplies". Checks can be mailed to PO Box 88, Dryden NY, 13053. If you would like to donate items, the District Office will have a decorated box for drop-offs and decorated boxes will also be located at Kinney Drugs and Holy Cross Church (provided by Elizabeth Palumbo and Sophia Lynch). Additional drop-off options: Tonya Dapp will be in her orange car on Fridays in the Clarks parking lot from 4pm-6pm to collect donations, you can leave them at your church, if it is open (we will make arrangements to pick them up), or you can contact Mary Hicks at 844-8694 ext. 1444 to arrange a pick up.
